



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO 2017- 11

**AN ORDER CREATING THE LOCAL INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE (LIAC) FOR THE
RESETTLEMENT OF INFORMAL SETTLERS ALONG ALL WATERWAYS AND OTHER
TRIBUTARIES TO MANILA BAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO,
PROVINCE OF BULACAN**

WHEREAS, Section 29 of Republic Act 7279, mandates the LGU, in coordination with NHA and other agencies, the relocation and resettlement of persons living in danger areas such as riverbanks, waterways, among others, and provide relocation and resettlement sites and basic services and facilities, access to employment and livelihood opportunities sufficient to meet the basic needs of the affected families;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2011-17 indicates that, "Enshrined in law and in the constitution is the promotion and protection of the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature. To tolerate informal settlements (IS) to build along "esteros", creeks, waterways, riverbanks and shorelines resulting into the unregulated discharge of domestic wastes into such water systems is a violation of this mandate";

WHEREAS, there must be an organized and well-coordinated committee to act as the decision-making and consultative body to implement and/or cause the carrying out of the various activities, plans, programs and projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JUANITO H. SANTIAGO, Municipal Mayor of Marilao, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by pertinent laws, do hereby ORDER:

Section 1. The creation of the Local Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC) to coordinate operationally the thrusts, objectives and activities of all agencies and organizations concerned in the smooth implementation of this project in accordance with laws and in providing basic social services and livelihood programs in resettlement sites.

Section 2. Composition. The Local Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC) for the resettlement of informal settlers along all waterways and other tributaries to Manila Bay shall be composed of the following:

Section 3. LIAC Secretariat. - The Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO) shall serve as Secretariat of the LIAC.

Section 4. Convening of the LIAC. - Upon approval and issuance of this Executive Order, a notice to convene the LIAC shall be disseminated accordingly by the LIAC Secretariat to all members.

Section 5. Objective of the LIAC. - The main objective of the LIAC is to formulate resettlement plans that include adequate basic social services, facilities and livelihood programs for the resettled families.

Section 6. Duties, Functions and Responsibilities. The LIAC shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. To determine thru public consultation the acceptability of the resettlement site to the stakeholders and endorse the resettlement site to concerned national agency;
- b. To formulate plan and undertake the provision of needed social service in health, education, security, environmental sanitation, etc. in the resettlement site;
- c. To develop and implement livelihood programs to generate employment and income opportunities for the resettled families;
- d. To organize and/or strengthen community-based organizations to facilitate the delivery of services in the resettlement projects.
- e. To top the assistance of National Agencies concerned in the implementation of the above objectives and coordinate with these agencies for the smooth relocation of the people.
- f. Perform other task that may be assigned from time to time relative to the implementation of the resettlement project.

Section 7. Role of Committee Members. - The members of the LIAC shall also act as focal persons within their respective Agencies/Departments/Offices/Organizations, for the purpose of facilitating the implementation of necessary programs/projects/activities pursuant to their respective mandates.





Section 8. Voting Rights of Committee Members. - Decisions in the LIAC shall be made through consensus. In the event no consensus is obtained, the decision shall be settled by a simple majority vote of the committee members.

Section 9. Funding. - The amount of _____ (PhP _____) is hereby set aside from available funds under the Office of the _____ for operational and logistical needs of LIAC activities such as consultations, meetings, workshops, secretariat and other needs for the purpose.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. - All previous issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order shall be deemed revoked or amended accordingly.

Section 11. Effectivity Clause. - This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
