



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2017- 08**

**CREATION OF MUNICIPAL TRICYCLE FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (MTFRB) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARILAO, BULACAN**

**WHEREAS**, Section 444 (B) (2) (iii) states that, "For the efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the General Welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall: Issue such executive orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances";

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Marilao approved its Revised Tricycle Code of the Municipality of Marilao on December 10, 2008 (Municipal Ordinance No. 664) and reorganized under Municipal Ordinance No. 702 on August 16, 2011, also known as "An Ordinance Reorganizing the Municipal Tricycle and Franchising and Regulatory Board amending for this purpose;

**WHEREAS**, considering their technical expertise in matters pertaining to tricycle for hire industry that will contribute to its efficiency, certain appointive officials should be given enhanced roles and functions in the regulation thereof, without however, abdication of the authority given by the law upon the Sangguniang Bayan in the regulation and franchising of tricycle for hire within the municipality;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to institutionalize the said Board to ensure the continuous implementation of the law;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JUANITO H. SANTIAGO**, Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the law, do hereby ORDER:

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.** The Municipal Tricycle and Franchising Regulatory Board (MTFRB) members shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 2. DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.** The Board shall perform the following powers, duties and functions:

- a. Issue/grant, suspend, declare null and void, cancel or otherwise revoke Franchises, subject to the provisions of existing law, ordinances, rules and regulations on the matter;
- b. Exercise direct control and supervision over all tricycle association within the Municipality. For the purpose, it can impose disciplinary measures against any association/member or officer who refuses or fails to comply with its order, after due hearing;
- c. Coordinate with neighboring municipalities and cities as regards to the monitoring and regulation of the operation of tricycle for hire;
- d. Review, approve or disapprove recommended decisions and orders of the TRU;
- e. Recommend and submit for review to the Sangguniang Bayan for appropriate legislative action, as well as measure governing tricycle for hire, such as the issuance or cancellation of franchise/operating permits, fares, zones, fees and other charges and implementation of other traffic laws;
- f. Recommend to the appropriate national governmental agency, in representation of the Municipal Government, for the prosecution, imposition of punitive sanctions, suspension, cancellation and revocation of franchises, permits, licenses, issued to erring tricycle for hire operators and drivers by the said agency;
- g. Promulgate rules and regulations for the proper enforcement of the Ordinance which shall continue to be in full force and effect until revoked or modified by the Sangguniang Bayan; and
- h. Perform such duties and other related functions.

**SECTION 3. SANCTIONS.** Failure or refusal without justifiable cause by any of the members to perform any of the foregoing duties shall be a ground for the imposition of administrative sanctions against the erring official/employee.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
